DROP-IN PUBLIC EXHIBITION ON DECEMBER 5
New Parking Zones in North Comely Bank, Craigleith and Orchard Brae

As you may be aware, your area is joining the Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) with controls in effect from 5 November 2007.

The first extensions to the city's CPZ since 1974 began operating last autumn. Residents within the new zones have given us a lot of positive feedback about the new zones, which are allowing them to regularly park near their homes for the first time in years. Many residents have also told us double parking has been reduced and their streets are safer.

Although the zones bring many benefits to residents, there are sometimes knock-on effects to surrounding streets, adjustments that need to be made to zone boundaries and other refinements that are required after a zone is introduced. Because of this, we will be monitoring traffic and parking in your area in the coming months, and we will hold a drop-in public exhibition in December.

At this exhibition, you will have the opportunity to look at displays on the controlled parking zone and parking survey data, give us suggestions for improvements, and talk one-on-one with Council transport officials to discuss your individual concerns.

Please note that there may be a short wait to talk to the relevant member of staff. We have found that most people come at the beginning of the meeting, so you may have a shorter wait if you arrive later.
